Modern Day Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy

Policy Statement

Measom Dryline Limited is committed to driving out acts of modern day slavery and human trafficking within its business and its sub-contractors and supply chain. The Company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within Measom Dryline and with sub-contractors and supplies of goods and services.

Measom is a family owned business that operates as a sub-contractor in the construction industry. The company has relationships with external business that supply products and labour only sub-contractors.

This policy statement will be reviewed annually and published.

Measom Dryline will not support or deal with any business that it finds is involved in slavery or human trafficking. The company Directors and Senior Management shall take the responsibility of implementing this Policy Statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate training and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the company or within the supply chain.

The Company will carry out a supplier approval process which will incorporate a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier as part of the due diligence processes. Imported goods are potentially more at risk for slavery/ human trafficking issues.

A full copy of this policy and a copy of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 will be accessible to all employees, and can be obtained from the HR department upon request.
